## Crockett Lake & Keystone Spit



## Bird & Wildlife Viewing Areas

1. **Gravel Ponds:** Parking near ponds.
2. **Birding Platform:** Turn into State Park area from Hwy 20, parking near platform. Scope or binocular recommended to view Crockett Lake, especially for shorebirds.
3. **Beach Access:** Great vistas of Admiralty Inlet and Keystone Spit beach.
4. **Keystone Harbor:** The rock jetty, old pier, Coupeville Ferry dock and surrounding areas offer many birding opportunities.
5. **Floodgate Area:** Additional views of Crockett lake. Parking west of restaurant.
